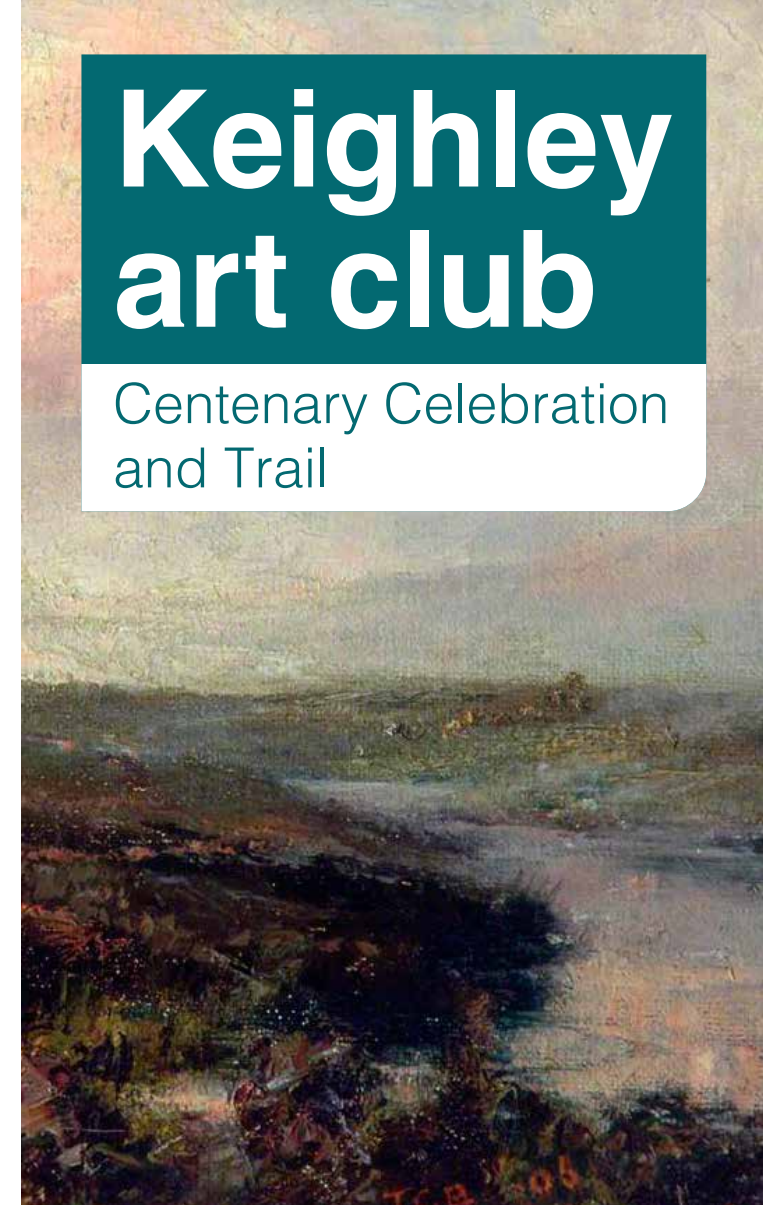

Follow this trail to see the artworks.



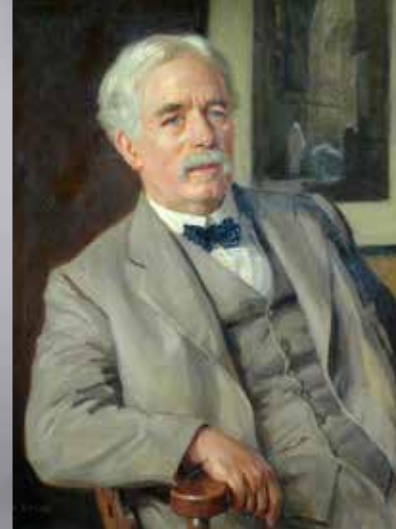
